

DORA GRIFFIN ARMSTRONG



15 May 1853-9 Oct 1918

- In the 1870 census Dora is 17 (b.1853) living with sister Lucinda Hampton in Huntsville, Texas
- Also living nearby in Huntsville is her brother Thomas Griffin who is also buried in the Conroe Community Cemetery. They both buy lots near each other in the Dugan community of Conroe.
- Her death certificate lists her father as Thomas Griffin born in Virginia.
- Dora's first husband is Riley Hubbard. They are married about 1880 and have two children, Arthur and Amanda.
- Dora's next husband is speculated to be a Smith since she is listed as Dorinda Smith when she
 marries her third husband Charles Harvey in 1887. Based on their birth year, Dora's children
 Lafayette (b. 1883) and William (b.1885) Armstrong's father could be Smith even though their
 death certificates show Elijah Armstrong as their father.
- Dora had a child, Nathaniel Harvey by her third husband Charles Harvey.
- Dora's fourth marriage is to Elijah Armstrong in 1890 (aka Lige or Leigh Armstrong).
- Both Charles Harvey & Elijah Armstrong have children by Laura Henderson who is buried in the Conroe Community Cemetery.
- Dora's occupation was a wash woman in her home. Her elegant monument is a testament to her resourcefulness and the love of her family.
