### Charlotte “Lottie” Carter

Charlotte (“Lottie”) Shelton Carter was born in December 1872 in Texas. At eight years of age, she lived with her Aunt and Uncle, Martha (Shelton) and Currie Williams, in Columbia, Brazoria County, Texas, along with their two children, Virginia and Julie Williams, Mike Shelton (likely Charlotte’s brother), and her Grandparents, Charlotte and Ike Shelton. Charlotte was likely named after her grandmother.

On 1 August 1889, Charlotte married Lucious (Luke) Carter in Wharton, Texas. Lucious Carter’s mother was Sarah Carter Scott who is listed on the headstone with Lottie Carter.

As shown in the 1900 United States Census for Montgomery County, Texas, Charlotte lived in Conroe, Montgomery County with her husband, Luke and three children who were living at that time, Twyphan, Marion C and Ethel. Three cousins also lived with Charlotte’s family, Henry Johnson, Eliza Johnson, and Annie Wilson.

Charlotte died on 17 December 1908. She was buried in the Conroe Community Cemetery. Her headstone is shared with Sarah Scott.
