Edwin Harvey

1911 – Edward Harvey was born on 30 September 1911 in Montgomery County, Texas. His mother, Ella McGee put his place of birth as "Lovelady" Texas on the death certificate. Ella was married to James or Jim Harvey in 1903. Edward had two brothers, Willie and John and one sister, Alzata. He also had step siblings.

1920 – In the 1920 US Census, Edward is living in ED 113 of Conroe with his parents, Jim and Ella. Jim is earning a wage as a laborer in public works along with Edward's two older step brothers, Aubrey Harvey (19) and Walter Woods (16), who also work there and live in the home. Also living in the home are his sister, Alsadia (12), a brother, Millie (11), a brother, Gabi (4) and his grandmother, Fannie Anderson (65).

1930 – In 1930, Edward is still living in Conroe with his parents, Jim (66) and Ella (45). Jim is a log hauler and Ella works in a private home. His step brothers Aubrey and Walter still live in the home but Walter is married and his wife, Alzona is living with them. Also in the home are his brothers Willie, (21) and J H (14) as well as two nieces, Laure (5) and Georgia (4). Edward and Willie are both working at the sawmill. The family lives next door to Laura Henderson, their grandmother.

1935 – On 22 November 1935, Edward dies in Conroe as a result of what appears on the death certificate to be "Pernicious Malaria and exhaustion." He was single and no known wife or children have been identified.

Edward is buried in the Conroe Community Cemetery, but due to the wear and tear on his grave marker, the name was difficult to read and was therefore entered as Edwin Harncy when it was recorded by <u>Horace and Oveta Wright in 1978</u>. Currently the headstone has not been found.
