Millie Holloman Drake

Millie Drake appears to be buried in the Conroe Community Cemetery. A temporary metal marker with only Millie Dr???? and dies April 14, ???? is still legible on the paper. She is found beside Little Lucille Drake so it is quite probable she is Millie Drake.

There is only one Drake family of African American descent in the 1880 - 1920 Censuses of Montgomery County. Texas.

Millie Holman is in the 1920 Census in Montgomery County, Texas. She is age 45 (b.1875), a roomer and a cook in a boarding house and divorced. She and her parents are born in Texas.

Phillip Drake is widowed and living with his mother in the 1920 Census of Montgomery County, Texas.

Phillip Drake, first son of Lafayette Drake and Susan Rose Drake, marries Millie Holloman on June 3, 1922. In 1926 Phillip Drake marries Mary Cooker so he has either divorced Millie or she has died.

Lafayette Drake dies after his last child Sam Drake is born in 1892. Susan Rose then marries Martin Jacob Dibbles, who is buried at the Conroe Community Cemetery, and then divorces him July 11, 1893.
